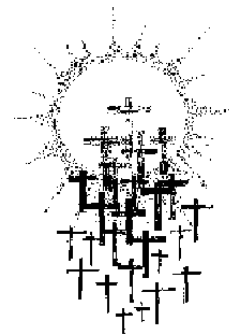

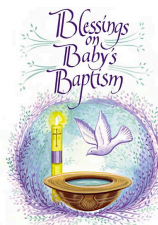
NY BUS TRIP 2014
