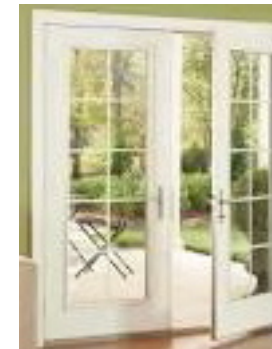


# PEACE RELEASE
