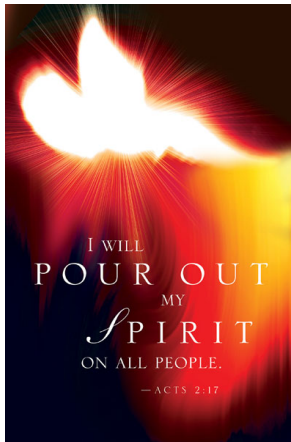




# PEACE RELEASE

Congratulations to both of you. We are proud of your accomplishments and pray God's blessing over you as you continue your walk with him.

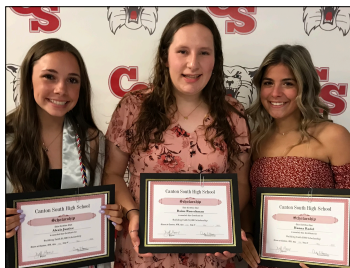


## OUR SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS
